

**FINANCIAL AGREEMENT
HHSBPA 2011 - 2012**

It is the intent of the Herndon Band Parent Association (HHSBPA) to allow any student to participate fully in the band activities throughout the school year. Should you require different payment arrangements than those listed below, you must contact in writing either the HHSBPA Treasurer or the Band Director, Ms. Schoelwer. Links to these individuals can be found at www.herndonband.org. Limited financial aid is available and is tied to fundraising efforts.

I understand that the anticipated fees for the 2011-2012 Band Year will be as follows:

Marching Season Fee \$425.00

To reserve your spot in the marching show, all forms and the initial deposit of \$125 must be received by **June 14, 2011**. The 2nd payment of \$150 is due **July 8** and the third and final payment of \$150 is due **August 5**.

Unless full payment is received or a Financial Aid Application is in place with the HHSBPA Treasurer prior to the last payment date of **August 5, 2011**, students may not be allowed to participate in Band Camp. Fees cannot be reimbursed once we have paid companies and instructors, so refunds are on a case by case basis.

Concert Fees \$100.00

Due in one payment by November 1, 2011.

The Spring Trip will require an additional payment to participate (usually \$500-\$600). Financial Aid is not available for the trip or for any other elective activity. Marching and Concert Fees also must be paid in full before you can participate in Spring Trip or additional elective activities (Winter Drumline, Winter Guard).

I also understand if a balance remains due on my student's account, the delinquent account will be turned over to Herndon High School for collection, and will be treated the same as any other outstanding student fee, including the resulting impact on the student's receipt of his/her diploma, parking passes, transcripts etc.

Any 2010-2011 outstanding balances must be paid before the last day of school. Should any new deposit be received, it will first be applied to outstanding balances.

Unpaid balances at the end of the school year may keep a student from participating in band activities in future years.
