



The Story Behind the Band Logo and the Show Shirts

Matt Wienke was one of those kids who lived in the band room. Matt's Senior year, he took English, Government and like 4 periods of band. He loved the Band. He designed the Band logo. He graduated in '88.

Band Director Rich Bergman took the Band to Mid-west in December of '87. Frank Wickes, Director of Bands LSU, walked up to Matt after the concert and offered Matt a free ride to LSU. There have been 3 others that Frank took to LSU -- Missy Rodgers, Rob Taylor and Stacy McCoy.

During Matt's Sophomore year at LSU, he was involved in an auto accident with an 18-wheeler, and he died. Matt's parents asked that contributions be made to the Pride of Herndon in Matt's memory. We used the money to buy the first show shirts. The thought process was that when the Band marches, Matt marches with the Band.

While at Mid-west in '88, a bunch of kids (10!) got sent home for drinking. But not Matt.

The first day back at school, the band sat in the band room and Rich Bergman asked what the Band should do. Matt said, "We play."

When K.C. Clendinen died a few years ago, we asked the kids what we should do and they said, "We play."

When Griffin O'Brien died, we asked the kids what we should do and they said, "We play."

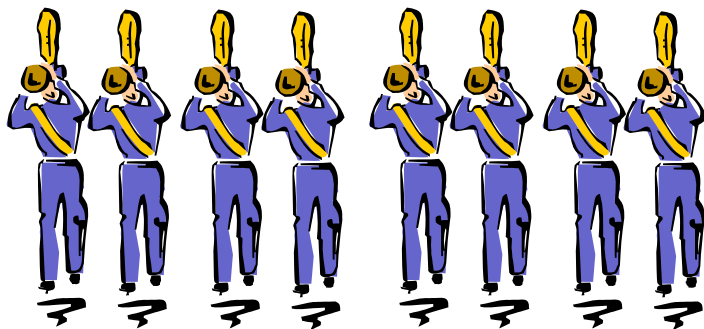

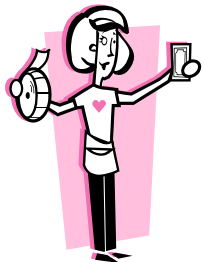

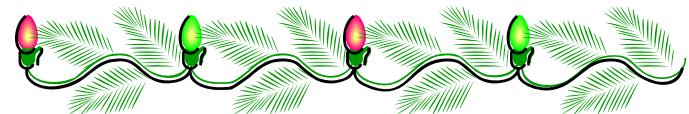
